

Bolton Soccer Incorporated Payment Policy

Adopted: 08/18/08

Registration Fees: Registration fees are due at the time of registration. Deadlines are clearly posted on the Bolton Soccer, Inc. web page and registration forms. Late fees will be assessed and collected after such dates have passed.

Division 4 Uniform Fees: Division 4 players are assessed an additional fee to cover the cost of uniforms on a yearly basis. A uniform consists of a jersey, shorts, socks and white conflict t-shirt. Uniforms become the property of the player. Loss or damage to such uniforms will result in additional replacement fees. Uniform fees will change from year to year based on manufacturer's availability and cost. Uniform fees are due upon being selected to a Division 4 team.

Returned Check Fees: There will be a \$25 fee for all checks returned as unpaid due to insufficient funds, stop payment, or any other form of cancellation.

Refunds: Bolton Soccer, Inc. reserves the right to cancel or consolidate programs if registration is insufficient. Any program canceled by Bolton Soccer, Inc. will result in a full refund. There are no refunds once a program begins. For the purposes of this policy, a program begins when:

- Rosters for Division 4 and 5 teams are finalized and submitted to the district. For the fall season this is typically the third week in August and for the spring season this is typically the first week of April.
- An Instructional Team (Grades Kindergarten through 2) meets for their first time (typically the first Saturday after the Labor Day holiday).

Refunds will not be issued for Division 4 uniforms once the order has been placed. Families may keep the uniforms but a refund cannot be issued.

All requests for refunds must be made in writing.

Inability to Pay: It is the belief of Bolton Soccer, Inc. that no registrant should be refused access to programs due to their inability to pay if additional funding can be secured. Confidential written application should be made to the Bolton Soccer, Inc. Board of Directors. If additional funding is available, the applicant may be granted a reduced or waived fee.
